The Living Faith ELCA Church Scholarship Application

Scholarship Guidelines:

- 1. The scholarships are available only to members of Living Faith Lutheran Church. Consideration shall be given to involvement in the church and the character of the applicant.
- 2. Applications for the scholarship are due May 1 prior to the fall school year.
- 3. Depending upon the available income, the scholarships shall be awarded in the following categories:
 - a. To students attending ELCA college, universities and seminaries.
 - b. To students attending four-year colleges or universities.
 - c. To students attending vocational or community colleges.
- 4. Depending upon the available funds, the scholarship(s) shall be awarded according to the following priorities:
 - a. First year students
 - b. Second year students
 - c. Third year students
 - d. Fourth year students
 - e. Graduate students
- 5. There is no limit as to how many years a scholarship can be awarded to an individual student. Scholarships are awarded subject to the available funds, the number of applicants, in accordance to the priorities stated above. Students attending ELCA seminaries are not considered with graduate students in the above priorities, but are considered with first, second- and third-year students.
- 6. The scholarship funds shall be sent directly to the educational institution.
